ORDER

1. This original application is relating to the news paper article published in

Indian Express pertaining to the untreated sewage flowing into the river Kham

wherein cognizance was taken by the Tribunal vide order dated 28.02.2022 and

a direction was given to the Chief Secretary, Maharashtra to call a meeting of

the concerned officers including Members of the RRC(River Rejuvenation

Committee), State Pollution Control Board and District Administration and

ensure that action taken report is filed in respect of status as on 31.05.2022

before the Pune Bench.

2. In compliance with said order, the report in the form of affidavit has been

filed by Aurangabad Municipal Corporation which is being represented today

before us by Learned Counsel Sh. Aniruddha Kulkarni.

3. The said affidavit contains the action taken in the matter so far which is

reproduced herein below:-

"a) AMC is operating 4 STPs of design cap. 211 MLD against the

present sewage generation of 96 MLD. The plants are designed

- to serve future population to the year 2030. Total 186 underground drainage line completed till date.
- b) AMC continues to fund expenditure through its allocated annual budget towards widening, deepening, channelizing, stone pitching and green cover augmentation along Kham River within limits of Municipal Corporation & the Cantonment Board area.
- c) AMC has made the provisions for door to door collection & segregation of solid waste using GPS enabled vehicles.
- d) AMC has installed 2 MSW processing sites with capacity 150 MT/D each & one MSW site having capacity 150 MT/D is under construction.
- e) One Bio-methanation plant for wet waste with capacity 30 MT/D is installed & 4 Material recovery facilities (MRF) having capacity 10 MT/D each are installed for processing of dry waste and 2 more MRF's with each 10MT/D cap. are proposed.
- f) Iron barricades are installed at 17 out of 26 bridges located on the Kham River & the rest 9 bridges will be completed within 30 days.
- g) Plastic traps are installed at five places on different nallah in Kham river basin to stop and remove the flowing the thermocal, plastic bags and other garbage on spot.
- h) AMC has undertaken projects for river rejuvenation and beautification since January 2021."
- 4. It appears that the District Collector, Aurangabad was also supposed to carry out marking of blue and red line of Kham river and was also to remove the illegal encroachment on Kham river within a period of six months but no report to that effect has been filed today before us.
- 5. It is further apprised by the Learned Counsel for the Aurangabad Municipal Corporation that there is another original application

no.29/2020(WZ) pending before us pertaining to the pollution of Kham river as

well as Sukna river which is listed for hearing before us on 21.09.2022.

6. We deem it proper to hear both the matters together and direct the

Registry to place this application on the same date for consideration.

7. In the meantime, the District Collector is directed to submit a report in

respect of the red line and blue line of the Kham river in compliance of the

directions given to him by the Chief Secretary, Maharashtra as per the affidavit

dated 07.07.2022 and place the same before us by the next.

8. We further direct the Registry to implead the Aurangabad Municipal

Corporation as Respondent No.1 and District Magistrate, Aurangabad as

Respondent No.2.

9. List the matter along with Original Application No. 29/2022(WZ) on
