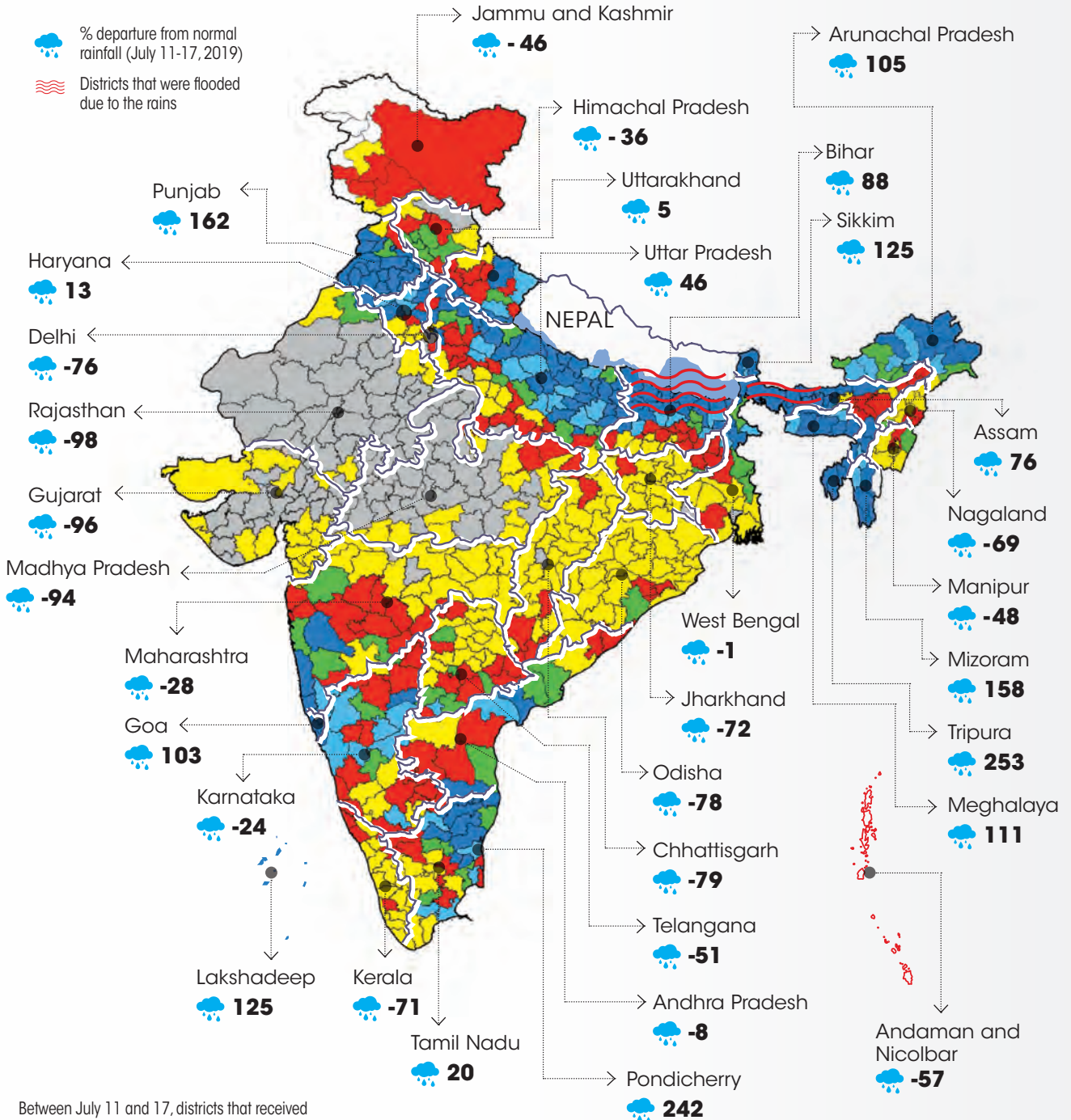


# A week of rains wreaks havoc

Twelve states in India received over 60 per cent surplus rains in the second week of July this year. The resultant floods in Bihar and Assam affected over 10 million and claimed 168 lives



Between July 11 and 17, districts that received

- ☑️ Large excess rainfall (60% or more)
- ☑️ Excess rainfall (20 to 59%)
- ☑️ Normal rainfall (-19 to 19%)
- ☑️ Large deficient rainfall (-99 to -60%)
- ☑️ Deficient rainfall (-59 to -20%)
- ☑️ No rainfall
